

## Game Recap for Wadena, Fargo, & River Lakes games

MBA Storm Bantams met on the Benson Civic Center ice on Nov 21 against the Wadena Bantams. MBA Matt Huot filled the net as goalie for the Storm. The other members of the team are: Isaac Berens, Mac Beyer, Austin Crow, Kell Engquist, Brody Gimberlin, Darion Helberg, Jacob Huston, Tanner Kirkeide, Tanner Picht, Andrew Rentz, Chad Schwarz, Luke Schwarz, and Jordan Staples. Storm Kelly Engquist and Andrew Rentz passed the puck to Tanner Kirkeide for the tip for the first period goal with 12:50 on the clock. Wadena had the only first period penalty for too many men on the ice. Neither team scored in the second period but both teams picked up penalties, MBA for hooking and Wadena for slashing both teams had the power play opportunity at different times but were unable to capitalize. Third period had Darion Helberg of the Storm tipping the puck on a pass from Isaac Berens and Jacob Huston at 14:24. MBA would be called for slashing but Wadena would not get a goal until after the penalty was over and Wadena Tyler Harthun would net the puck at 6:59. MBA scored two more goals at 6:32 Darion Helberg picked up his second goal on a set up from Brody Gimberlin and Luke Schwarz, the last goal came right after the face off with Andrew Rentz passing to Kelly Engquist for the goal. Final score 4 to 1 MBA Storm over Wadena.

On Nov 22 the MBA Bantams travelled to Fargo to face off against the Fargo North Raiders. The Storm took the early lead with a goal at 8:14 by Mac Beyer assisted by Jordan Staples and Luke Schwarz. Fargo picked up a tripping penalty with :35 seconds left on the clock. The second period had the Storm capitalize on the first period penalty with Isaac Berens and Tanner Picht assisting Mac Beyer for a power play goal at 14:40. Fargo was called for a head contact penalty at 10:22, MBA followed with a penalty for tripping at 5:25. MBA controlled the puck and got a short handed goal off the pass from Jake Huston to Mac Beyer at 4:31. Fargo again got called for a penalty for elbowing at 3:57 and the Storm netted the puck again for the power play goal with Beyer and Berens getting the puck to Andrew Rentz at 3:04. The Storm skated well and netted a goal with Luke Schwarz and Darion Helberg passing to Brody Gimberlin at 13:15 and Jake Huston rushed the puck the full length of the ice for an unassisted goal at 10:53. Fargo had a boarding penalty at 10:10 and MBA Kelly Engquist passed the puck to Jake Huston for a power play goal at 8:23. Final score 7 to 0 with a Storm win, MBA Austin Crow had 15 saves in the game as goalie and Fargo goalies had 34.

On Nov 23 the Storm played at the Lee Community Center against the River Lakes Stars. The Stars were called for the first penalty at 11:56 for tripping, MBA followed at 10:56 for roughing. The Storm scored at 6:46 with Kelly Engquist and Darion Helberg assisting Luke Schwarz. The second goal came off the combo of Tanner Picht to Jordan Staples for the goal. Period two had Tanner Kirkeide called for roughing at 12:04 and it gave River Lakes Stars the power play goal at 10:46. MBA had two penalties for interference at 7:19 and tripping at 6:42. With 4:31 on the clock Luke Schwarz got an unassisted goal. The Storm had a 3 to 1 lead going into the third period. With 11:34 on the clock Mac Beyer got the pass for Chad Schwarz for a goal. River Lakes was called for unsportsmanlike conduct at 4:55. Final score 4 to 1 Storm win. Saves for MBA goalie Matt Huot 6 and River Lakes goalie 19 saves.
