

MBA BHS vs LDC

Mike Morales, Peter Lindblad, and Tyler Hansen each scored two goals and Andreas Siggelin and Brady Valnes both scored once to lead the MBA Storm to an 8-5 win over Litchfield/Dassel Cokato on Tuesday, December 9th at the Benson Civic Center. With the win the Storm evened their season's record at 1-1 heading into their next game on Saturday, Dec. 13th in Windom.

Morales got MBA off to a good start against LDC as he scored at the 5:04 mark of the first period with Lindblad picking up an assist. Siggelin gave the Storm a two goal lead scoring at the 6:40 mark with assists going to Morales and Jake Manska before the Dragons would get on the scoreboard to make the score 2-1 at the first period intermission. Storm goalie Will Johnson had 14 saves in the period and the Dragon goalie, Bryce Johnson made 5.

Morales scored the first goal of the second period as well, scoring unassisted just 56 seconds into the period but LDC closed the gap to 3-2 with a goal of their own at the 8:44 mark. Lindblad then scored a big goal for the Storm, scoring unassisted with just 12 seconds remaining to regain a two goal lead for MBA. Saves for the period were 8 for W. Johnson, and 3 for B. Johnson.

LDC started out quick in what would turn out to be a wild, high scoring third period with two goals in the first 2:51 of play and suddenly the game was tied at 4-4. MBA would regain the lead at the 6:50 mark when Valnes converted on a pretty pass from behind the net by Ethan Ratliff-Crain. The Dragons however would answer with another goal just 2:12 later and the score was tied again. Hansen then scored the eventual game winner with assists to Lindblad and Morales at the 10:00 minute mark and Lindblad added an unassisted goal 1:26 later. MBA would take a penalty with 2:30 remaining and LDC decided to pull their goalie in an attempt to close the gap. A Lindblad breakaway caused a Dragon player to get a tripping penalty however to even things up at four on four and then Hansen closed the scoring with an empty net goal at the 15:37 mark. MBA's Will Johnson made 7 more saves in the period for a game total of 29 and LDC's B. Johnson came up with 8 saves in the period for a game total of 16.
