

MBA vs Sleepy Eye

A 9-0 win in Sleepy Eye on Tuesday, January 20th ran the MBA Storms' record to 6-5-1. All three Storm goalies had a hand in the shutout as Andrew Fath stopped 10 Indian shots in the first period, Alex Sinclair stopped the only shot that he saw in the second, and Will Johnson blanked Sleepy Eye on 8 attempts in the third.

Tyler Hansen got the Storm on the board 3:35 into the game when he scored unassisted. Hansen then assisted Peter Lindblad on the next MBA goal at the 10:01 mark and Lindblad scored the final goal of the first period with assists going to Ethan Ratliff-Crain and Thomas Horecka at 15:29.

The second period was all Storm as well as Dustin Sauter scored first with assists going to Horecka and Ratliff-Crain at 9:50 and Hansen scored assisted by Lindblad just 16 seconds later. Sauter got the next MBA goal with the assist going to Mike Morales at 13:54 and then Lindblad closed out the second period scoring, assisted by Hansen and Brady Valnes at 15:33.

MBA scored both of the goals in the final period, with Lindblad getting his fourth of the night on assists from Hansen and Morales at 7:15 and Hansen closed out the scoring by completing his hat trick when he scored on a rebound of a Sauter shot with 5:16 remaining in the game.

On tap for MBA this week is a 1:00 game on Saturday, the 26th against Worthington in Benson, a make-up game at 5:00 on Tuesday the 27th against Breck/Wahpeton in Morris, and the Storm close out the week with a trip to Luverne for a 3:00 game on Saturday the 31st.
