

The second round of the MBA Storm Varsity girls playoffs took place on the ice of Fergus Falls. Second seed Fergus Falls versus third seed MBA Storm facing off in the second round. The winner would skate against Alexandria in the section championship.

Fergus Falls Johnson was called for checking with 16:34 on the clock. MBA played a strong power play but couldn't get on the scoreboard. Storm Emily Rajewsky was called for roughing at 7:46 and the Otters capitalized on the power play scoring at 6:34 off the stick of Vatnsdal, assists to Styve and Magnusson. The Storm came back strong with Dani Staples controlling the puck the length of the ice for an unassisted goal to tie the game at 1 all with 6:02 on the clock. Fergus Falls Johnson was called for her second penalty, checking again, at 5:18 but the power play for Storm was short lived when Storm Dani Schultz was called for holding. Fergus Falls Anderson would net the puck at 3:28 with the assist to Underwood. Miller of Fergus Falls would be called for tripping at 2:27 bring the period to an end with the Storm trailing by 1 goal. Saves for MBA Horecka 8 and Fergus Falls 3.

The Storm would tie up the game at 15:46 on a shot from center ice from Storm Katia Vantries, the goalie would attempt to play the puck and missed as the puck went into the net for the goal. The penalties continued on the Storm as Sara Rajewsky was called for tripping at 14:23. Fergus worked the puck well and scored as the penalty ended 12:16 when Fergus Falls Masten got the pass from Vatnsdal and Underwood. Masten of the Otters would be called for tripping at 9:17 but the Storm struggled to hit the net. The puck would be coming off the sticks of the Storm high or wide. Abby Knutson had some awesome stops along the board as she pinched the puck to stop the attack. At 5:25 Fergus Falls Clark would get a pass from Masten for a goal. With :26 on the clock Vatnsdal for the Otters would be called for tripping and the Storm would let their guard down and Fergus would get the short handed goal off the stick of Underwood with :18 on the clock. The Storm had a three goal deficit on their hands to deal with going into the third period. The saves for MBA 10 and Fergus Falls 0.

The third period showed the Storm slowing on the warm ice. Players were changing more frequently. Fergus Falls Anderson was called for roughing at 14:28. MBA Sara Rajewsky got her skates moving for a goal at 10:14 but again the excitement was short lived as the Storm let the Otter Johnson with the assist to Anderson come right back for a goal at 9:35. Otter Vatnsdal was called for interference at 8:02 but the Storm was still struggling to find the net. MBA called a timeout to give the lines some rest. The Storm pulled the goalie to add the extra skater but to no avail as they were defeated 3 to 6 to end their playoff run. Saves for MBA Horecka 7 for a game total of 25 and saves for Fergus Falls 7 for a game total of 10.
