

Back to winning.....

The Storm did come to skate against the Eagles and the score really doesn't reflect the pressure the Storm put on the Windom Eagles on Saturday 1/26/2008.

With 15:57 on the clock Storm Emily Rajewsky was in front of the net to score on the pass from Dani Staples and Dani Schultz. The Eagles Luhmann got a break away and scored with 6:38 on the clock. The Storm quickly shut the Eagles down in any further attempt. Dani Staples of the Storm put the puck in the net with 6:17 answering back the Eagle goal on the assist from Dani Schultz and Sara Rajewsky. MBA Brooke Anderson took the first penalty with 2:59 left in the period when she was called for checking. MBA Brooke Falk was in the net for the Storm, saves for Falk in the first period 3 and for Eagles goalie 22. The Storm was up 2 to 1 on the scoreboard.

The Storm would notch two more goals in the second period the first coming with 7:00 left in the period off the stick of Katia Vantries on the assist of Sara Rajewsky. Followed by an unassisted goal from Sara Rajewsky at 5:39. The score was 4 to 1 in favor of the Storm and the shots again were commanding for the Storm, 15 shots for MBA and 2 for the Eagles. This brought the game total shots for MBA to 37 and the Eagles with only 5. The Eagle goalie was doing a great job of keeping the Storm at bay.

The Eagles struggle to get the puck passed center ice into the Storm zone continued and penalties made it more difficult on the team. At 11:47 the Eagles' Dane was called for hooking followed by Kerkaert for tripping at 10:40. Storm Ali Sinclair scored at 8:03 with the assist to Katia Vantries as the Storm kept the puck in the Eagle zone. With 4:59 on the clock Eagle Luhmann as called for slashing and MBA Vantries followed into the box at 3:00 with an interference penalty. The game was completely in the control of the Storm and the Eagles struggle to get and keep any control of the puck. Storm Brooke Anderson scored an unassisted short handed goal with 2:03 left on the clock to make the final score 6 to 1. Shot for the Storm in the third period 26 with 3 shots for the Eagles, game total MBA shots 63 and Eagles shots 8. The Storm face Little Falls for the second time of the season on Tuesday at the Lee Community Center.
