

The Storm headed to Little Falls to play hockey November 20 and play they did!! Flyers Gerads second goal was unassisted and Sara Rajewsky, Kelly Mahoney, Katia Vantries, Abby Knutson and Brooke Anderson were defending. After the 2 goal lead MBA had to shake lose and score. With 11:20 on the clock Abby Knutson and Monica Lindblad held the zone with Katia Vantries while Dani Schultz got the puck to Brooke Anderson for the Storm goal. With the same sticks still on the ice Dani Schultz netted the tying goal at 11:07. MBA Knutson would be called for hooking at 5:57 and the Storm easily held the Flyers off the net with Brooke Falk as the Storm goalie. Saves for MBA Falk 7 and the Flyers 14 saves and the score would remain tied 2 to 2.

The second period had Little Falls Marmon being called for tripping at 16:34. Dani Staples took the advantage and broke through for an unassisted power play goal at 15:27 with Brooke Anderson, Abby Knutson, Dani Schultz and Emily Rajewsky as on ice support. Little Falls Arndt brought the puck in with assists to Orth and Gerads at 11:42, Storm Lindblad, Knutson, Emily and Sara Rajewsky and Celeste Evenson being unable to get the puck control. With 7:59 on the clock Dani Staples picked up the pace and scored her second unassisted goal with Abby Knutson, Sam Falk, Emily and Sara Rajewsky sharing the ice. Little Falls answered back with a goal from Stumpf and the assist to Amber Arndt at 6:46, Storm defending Lindblad, Falk, Knutson and Emily & Sara Rajewsky. The scoring was not ending as both teams had the swing of the ice. The Storm needed to take control and put the game in their favor. With 5:46 on the clock the struggle in front of the net had Kelly Mahoney getting the puck to Celeste Evenson for the goal with Dani Staples, Dani Schultz and Brooke Anderson backing up. And 30 seconds later Sam Falk tipped the puck in the goal with the assist to Emily & Sara Rajewsky. The blue line was being held tight by Staples and Mahoney. Both the Storm Sara Rajewsky at 4:39 called for tripping and the Flyers LaPorte for hooking at 4:07 on Staples. With both teams on a four on four Flyer Gerads picked up her third goal of the game with the assist to Atkinson, with Storm Lindblad, Anderson, Schultz and Knutson skating. Brooke Anderson brought the Storm back again with a power play goal at 2:22 with Staples, Mahoney, Sam Falk and Sara Rajewsky defending. The Storm moved ahead of the Flyers to end the second period with a 7 to 5 lead.

Scoring and penalties kept the third period as active as the first two. MBA Knutson was called for interference at 16:32 and the Storm held strong against the Flyers power play. At 13:47 MBA Dani Schultz scored an unassisted goal with back up coming from Staples, Anderson, Lindblad and E Rajewsky. MBA Knutson and Flyers Wenner were called for coincidental roughing penalties at 13:31. Brooke Anderson of the Storm took the puck to the net at 10:12 for unassisted goal with Lindblad, Knutson, Schultz and Vantries in the zone. The struggle continued as the Flyers were called for checking at 9:37 and MBA Evenson was called for checking at 8:34. Gerads for the Flyers picked up her fourth goal at 5:38 assisted by CJ Arndt, Storm defenders Devon Ratliff-Crain, Liz Vick, Celeste Evenson, Abby Knutson, Moriah Hovde. The Flyer Gerads had the puck and was cutting into the Storm zone when Dani Staples defending went to cut her off taking her off her skates, Staples would be called for a checking major penalty (5 min) at 4:50 on the clock. The Storm held the puck in the Flyer zone despite being a skater short until the Flyers were called by checking at 1:39 and again a Flyer penalty at :52 (bench minor) for too many skates on the ice. The Storm now had the third straight win of the season as they headed to the locker room with a 9 to 6 victory!! Brooke Falk had an excellent night in the goal for the Storm
