

On the road the Storm traveled to Long Prairie for the rematch with Wadena/Long Prairie/Grey Eagle/Deer Creek Blue Devils. In their first game the Storm came away with the win in OT. It would be the same tough game but the outcome was not favorable for the Storm.

In the first period at 15:51 the Storm Sam Falk was called for hooking but the Blue Devils were held scoreless until 4:44, Blue Devil Wright scored with assist to Gorka. With :33 left Wright of the Blue Devils scored again on a breakaway with the assist to Zalc. MBA was down two goals and had only three shots on the net while the Blue Devils had 8 shots with two of them being goals.

The Storm finally got on the scoreboard with a goal from Dani Schultz with the assist to Emily Rajewsky at 15:15, backing them up on the ice Abby Knutson and Monica Lindblad at the blue line and Katia Vantries screening by the net. Blue Devils would have two skaters in the box, at 13:09 Zalc for checking and 11:30 Wright for tripping, but the Storm could not get the puck past Blue Devil goalie Kayla Guck, she was having an awesome game in the net. MBA Anderson was called for tripping at 9:46 with Blue Devil Lemke following for hooking at 9:32 and MBA Sara Rajewsky at 9:03 for checking. Both teams held a tough defense and no pucks penetrated. Blue Devil Lemke would be called for checking again at 5:50. A high stick would be called on the Blue Devils and the puck was brought out of the zone and on the attack again the Blue Devils would be called for roughing but before they could touch the puck for the whistle of the penalty the Storm Vantries were called for slashing at 2:24. MBA had pushed hard and had 16 shots on Blue Devil Guck with only one goal to show for their efforts. The Blue Devils were only able to get four shots on MBA Hannah Horecka to end the second period.

Blue Devils would send Zalc to the penalty box for her third penalty of the game at 11:58, this time for interference and the Storm were unable to keep control of the puck and Blue Devil Bjorge would take it in for a short handed goal at 11:27 with Falk, Rajewsky, Schultz, Staples and Anderson on the power play. MBA Sara Rajewsky was called for checking at 10:02 and at 9:53 Gorka of the Blue Devils would be called for checking. Three more penalties would happen before the game would come to a close MBA Sara Rajewsky for roughing and Blue Devil Dykhoff for roughing at 7:39 and Blue Devil Behl for hooking at 4:09. The Storm would take a time out to regroup for another attempt for a goal. With 1:46 on the clock and the struggle in front of the net with Schultz, Staples, Rajewskys and Sam Falk the puck would cross the line with Sam Falk in for the goal. Guck of the Blue Devils was again tough the Storm had 8 shots and the Blue Devils only 3. Total shots for the Storm 27 and the Blue Devils 13 but the score had MBA 2 and the Blue Devils 3. Blue Devil Kayla Guck had a great game and handed the Storm their first loss of the season.
