

Redwood Valley Varsity Girls traveled to the Benson Civic Center to play against the MBA Storm girls 12/20/07. The Storm took to the ice and had the first goal at 11:09 with Dani Schultz getting the goal and Dani Staples and Sam Falk getting the assist. The Storm kept up the scoring and the entire Storm bench was taking their shifts on the ice. Moriah Hovde scored on the pass from Celyst Evenson at 6:23. The Storm continued the last three minutes with an onslaught of goals, Brooke Anderson with the assist to Dani Schultz at 3:12. Dani Schultz followed with a goal at 2:39 with the assist to Liz Vick. In less than thirty seconds Sam Falk hit the net on the pass from Katia Vantries at 1:54. The Storm didn't let up and Brooke Anderson got the pass from Dani Staples and Emily Rajewsky for a goal with :50 on the clock. MBA Evenson would be called for tripping with :25 on the clock.
