

The MBA Storm Varsity Hockey girls took part in the Willmar Holiday Hockey tournament Dec 26 to the 28, 2007. The teams participating in the tournament were Willmar, Litchfield-Dassel-Cokato, Mankato East, Windom, MBA, Detroit Lakes. The first team the Storm faced was Detroit Lakes and it didn't end as well as the regular season game with a Storm win the Detroit Lakes girls pushed the game into overtime and took the win. The first period had no scoring and both teams had 6 shots each on net. The second period had Katia Vantries of the Storm being called for tripping at 13:54 with Detroit Lakes being held off until after the penalty was done but scored at 10:23 with Rusness scoring and Nielsen getting the assist. MBA Brooke Anderson, Sara Rajewsky, Katia Vantries, along with defense Kelly Mahoney and Abby Knutson fought to get the puck out of the zone. Dani Schultz and Sam Falk of the Storm both had a great rush to the net but both shots were deflected off the goalie stick and over the net. DL Seebold was called for high stick at 7:31 and again for tripping at 5:24 against Anderson in the corner. MBA Brooke Anderson tied the score on the power play goal at 4:05. DL Harms gave the Storm another power play opportunity at 2:58 for slashing Sara Rajewsky at the net. The teams started the third period tied 1 to 1 but would have both teams not able to score. The teams went into a sudden death overtime of 8 minutes and the Storm would allow DL Braun the goal at 6:35 giving them the win. Hannah Horecka was in the net for the Storm.

The Storm would arrive at Willmar on Dec 27 to face off against Mankato East-Loyola which were coached by a former MBA boys coach Nate Fuller. Brooke Falk took the goalie position for the Storm. The MEL team scored first 3:32 into the period but the Storm came back with the Rajewsky sisters scoring 11:20 into the period and Dani Schultz would take the pass from Anderson for the goal 12:07 into the period. Dani Schultz and Sam Falk teamed up and picked up two more goals to end the first period and start the second period. With the score 4 to 1 the Storm Emily Rajewsky was called for interference and the Storm scored a short handed goal on the pass from Sam Falk to Sara Rajewsky. MEL Stephanie Anderson scored 13:39 into the period on the pass from Hoffman & Quandt to end the second period. The third period had MEL Stephanie Anderson called for hooking 4:42 into the period and MBA Brooke Anderson scored a power play goal :05 seconds after the penalty. MBA Schultz and Falk did the scoring again 7:56 into the period and MEL Anderson would be called for elbowing and the Storm Dani Staples got the pass to Falk to Schultz for the power play goal a minute into the penalty. The third period had plenty of activity as the Storm let down their guard and MEL scored two unanswered goals in less than a minute off the sticks of Carey Hoffman and Stephanie Anderson combination. With 2.5 minutes left in the period Abby Knutson of the Storm got the pass to the Rajewsky sisters for the last goal of the game. Hoffman of MEL would be called for hooking with :04 seconds left but the Storm already had the win with a final score of 9 to 4 to move them into the third place game on Dec 28.

The Storm would be facing a team they had already skated against twice this season Litchfield-Dassel-Cokato and taken a win against. Brooke Falk would be in the goal for the Storm, sister Sam Falk got the pass to Sara Rajewsky for the first goal with 7:02 on the clock and Staples and Mahoney holding the blue line. MBA Abby Knutson would go to the penalty box for interference in front of the net at 5:24 and Sara Rajewsky would score the short handed goal at 3:59. Saves for MBA Falk 9 and LDC 16 and the Storm was up by 2 goals. Dani Staples of the Storm would start the scoring from the point to the top corner glove side with the pass coming from Sara Rajewsky at 9:50. The penalty was coming against the Storm Staples for tripping at the net but would be nullified because LDC Grangroth would score. MBA Staples would be called for hooking at 4:57 but LDC could not capitalize. With :23 seconds on the clock LDC was called for holding to end the period. The third period had Hannah Horecka taking the net for the Storm and neither team were able to score. Coincidental penalties for high sticking were called with two minutes left on the clock and a checking penalty against LDC Corbin when she hit Staples mid ice. Final score 3 to 1. MBA total saves 25 and LDC total saves 35. The Storm came home with a 2 to 1 tournament record and the third place trophy.
