

The participated in the Wadena Hockey Rocks Invitational Tournament on Dec 7 - 9, 2007. Other teams participating were Wadena, Prairie Centre, Warroad, Detroit Lakes, and MBA.

On December 7 Wadena 6 vs Prairie Centre 3, December 8 Wadena faced off against the MBA Storm. The Storm Brody Gimberlin got the first goal at 2:31 left in the first period with the assist to Tanner Picht and Tanner Mikkelson. The second period had no scoring on the part of the Storm but Wadena would be able to net three goals with the first one at 14:30. MBA Staples and Wadena Pettit would be called for roughing at 13:22. Wadena put away two more goals at 8:00 and 7:27 to put them up 3 to 1. And yet another coincidental penalty would be called on MBA Picht and Wadena Pettit again for roughing with Wadena adding another player to the box for interference at 1:22. Giving the Storm the advantage did not help as they still were unable to score. MBA Beyer would go to the box at 14:36 for boarding and Staples followed at 13:00 for interference. Wadena scored on the power play at 12:13. Wadena saw the penalty box at 8:56 for boarding and after the penalty they scored another goal at 6:37. With 4:39 on the clock a tripping penalty was called on Wadena and Storm Tanner Mikkelson was able to score on the pass to the point from Tanner Picht at 4:04. Two more penalties one on MBA for roughing and one on Wadena for elbow but neither team scored. Final score had the win going to Wadena. The next game was Warroad 2 vs Detroit Lakes 6 and then MBA took the ice again this time against Prairie Centre.

The first period only had MBA Staples in the penalty box for elbow at :55. Saves for MBA 1 and Prairie Centre 11. The second period had Nate Nelson of the Storm serving a penalty for too many skaters on the ice at 11:42 and Tanner Picht would score short handed for the first goal. MBA Jordan Staples would score unassisted to put the Storm up 2 to 0 but Prairie Centre netted two goals to end the period in a tie 2 to 2. Saves for MBA 6 and Prairie Centre 15. Both teams put forth an effort but were unable to break the tie in the third period. Saves for MBA 8 and Prairie Centre 9. Final score 2 to 2.

Game five had Wadena 11 vs Detroit Lakes 3.

Game six had Prairie Centre 9 vs Warroad 1.

December 9 had the Storm on the ice against Warroad. The first period had MBA Tanner Picht getting the pass from Riley Blake for the goal with only :40 seconds off the clock. MBA Jacob Aarhus was called for tripping but the Storm kept the control of the puck. MBA Lincoln Pahl scored on the pass from Tanner Picht and Jordan Staples and continuing the scoring Tanner Picht scored on the pass from Darion Helberg. Before the period ended Storm Tanner Picht scored a hat trick for the team and himself. MBA saves 3 and Warroad 15. With the Storm up 4 to 0 the second period would start with Warroad going to the penalty box for cross check and then hooking. MBA Mac Beyer netted a puck but Storm Brody Gimberlin would be called for roughing with Beyer following for roughing too. The Storm kept up the pace and control of the puck from Warroad. Warroad would go to the penalty box for head contact and MBA Beyer scored again to put the Storm with a 6 goal lead. The third period MBA Brody Gimberlin scored on the pass from Tanner Mikkelson. Warroad had an unsportsmanlike penalty to start out the third period and MBA Staples had a roughing penalty. MBA Tanner Mikkelson scored the short handed goal. Jordan Staples of the Storm scored from the point on the pass from Chad Schwarz. The Storm kept the pressure on and Storm Brody Gimberlin got the puck to Jacob Aarhus for the next goal. The Storm would have a tripping penalty and an interference penalty but Warroad didn't even get a shot on the MBA net. Final score 10 to 0

Final Game MBA vs Detroit Lakes this game had plenty of skating in all three periods but the scoring and penalties all happened in the first and third period. Jordan Staples of the Storm scored unassisted to start the action at 14:11 on the clock. MBA Tanner Picht repeated the actions of his teammate and scored unassisted at 13:27. The Storm Beyer was called for roughing at 7:16. MBA saves 3 and DL saves 19 the Storm was putting the puck on the net. The second period had the MBA saves at 3 and DL saves 22. MBA Lincoln Pahl scored at 14:36 with teh assist to Tanner Picht and Chad Schwarz. MBA would be called for two separate penalties

holding at 12:50 and elbowing at 10:31. Detroit Lakes would get a puck in the net at 6:11 and MBA Tanner Picht would answer back at 5:42 unassisted. MBA would get called for tripping at 1:21 and an elbow penalty at :26. The Storm took the win 4 to 1, saves in the third period MBA 7 and DL 8.
