

The Morris Hockey Association and Lee Community Center hosted a Pee Wee B hockey tournament on Dec 15 & 16, 2007. Teams participating were MBA Storm, Monticello-Annandale-Maple Lake, Detroit Lakes, and Wadena. MBA hit the ice for the first game against Monticello-Annandale-Maple Lake (MAML). The Storm started the scoring at 13:16 with Tanner Picht getting the pass from defense Tanner Mikkelson. MAML was called for holding at 5:52 but the Storm could not get the puck to the net for a goal on the power play. MBA Riley Blake would score unassisted after the penalty expired. The Storm was up 2 goals and wanted to keep the lead. MBA saves for period one 1 and saves for MAML 6. The Storm was skating strong and getting the puck to the net but even better keeping the puck away from their net.

The second period had no scoring but MAML was called for interference at 10:01 and the Storm Blake was called for interference at 7:49. MAML was called for hooking at :30 left in the period. MBA saves 4 and MAML 6.

The Storm would need to hold off the MAML skaters for a full period. The Storm Staples would be called for roughing at 10:15 and the MAML skaters would score at 10:10. The Storm only had a one goal lead and 10 minutes left in the game. The Storm would keep the MAML skaters at bay but did not make a statement at the net. The Storm won 2 to 1, saves for each team for the third period were four each.

Game 2 had Wadena taking the win over Detroit Lakes with a score of 9 to 3

Game 3 had MAML winning over Detroit Lakes 7 to 4.

Game 4 had the MBA Storm taking the ice against Wadena. Wadena would score first at 12:56 but would be called for interference at 12:03 and holding. The Storm was ready to skate on the power play and with Jordan Staples and Tanner Picht getting the puck to Brody Gimberlin the puck found the net at 10:57 for the power play goal. Wadena came back and scored at 8:06 moving the score to 2 to 1 with Wadena in the winning position. The penalties would continue with Wadena being called for roughing at 4:15. The Storm needed to get on the ice and skate making the second period their period. MBA saves 5 and Wadena 7 and the Wadena skaters had the 2 to 1 lead. MBA would score at 11:03 Darion Helberg passing to Mac Beyer. Wadena again went to the penalty box for inference and unsportsman like conduct at 10:09. Storm Picht was called for boarding at 8:25 but the Storm held the zone well and no goals were scored. Mac Beyer of the Storm followed for an elbow penalty at 7:14. Taner Gimberlin of the Storm caught the pass for Mac Beyer and Jordan Staples for a goal at 4:48 but the Storm allowed the Wadena skaters to answer right back with goal at 4:17. The period would have the Storm Darion Helberg in the penalty box for tripping at 2:33. Wadena was working hard to get the puck and would be called for roughing at :12. MBA saves 7 and Wadena 6. The Storm kicked up the play and netted a goal at 6:57 Tanner Picht and Taner Gimberlin passed the puck to Riley Blake for the goal. Wadena was called for tripping at 6:15. With 4:57 on the clock Wadena netted the puck to tie the score. The pressure was on the Storm for a goal. MBA Tanner Picht would get the puck across the line and score at 1:17 on the clock, Mac Beyer assisted. The only had to keep the Wadena skaters out of the zone for the final minute. Wadena was called for hooking at the buzzer and the Storm got the hard skated win 5 to 4. Both teams played a strong, even game.

Game 5 had Wadena winning over MAML 3 to 2

The final game had Morris taking over the game against Detroit Lakes. DL was called for boarding at 13:03 and the Storm scored at 11:55 on the pass from Brody Gimberlin and Jordan Staples to Mac Beyer. The Storm had three more goals in a row. MBA Jordan Staples scored unassisted at 7:09 followed by Brody Gimberlin with the assist to Ty Bellmore and Darion Helberg. Taner Gimberlin of the Storm got the pass to Mac Beyer for a goal at 5:58. The Storm allowed a goal off the stick of a DL skater at 4:21 to get DL on the scoreboard. MBA Corey Storck worked the puck into the front of the net and Riley Blake netted the puck at 2:38. The Storm controlled the puck, were getting the shots on the net and keeping the puck away from their net. MBA Brody Gimberlin scored unassisted at 9:54. DL came back and scored at 4:21. The Storm got the control and Taner Gimberlin scored on the pass from Tanner Picht at 2:46 and

Mac Beyer would score on the pass from Riley Blake at 1:05. The Storm had a commanding lead of 8 to 2 going into the third period. The Storm worked the puck around and kept the shots going to the net. at 12:47 Storm Aarhus was called for slashing and at 10:03 on the clock Nate Nelson of the Storm scored on the pass from Beyer. Final score 9 to 2 giving the Storm first place in the tournament. Wadena took second, MAML third and Detroit Lakes fourth.
